Highlights of Keith's campus work in March were A Taste of Oasis at both U. of Guelph and U. of Waterloo featuring a multimedia production by Spectrum A&E Media entitled *Seismic Shift: Spirituality for the Rest of Us*, and a 'Community Moment' at UG by Anna Yo. A Taste of Oasis was part of a **Multifaith Week** at U. of G, including a vigil for victims of the New Zealand massacre and other acts of religious violence around the world. Keith also facilitated a 4 week discussion of Jordan Peterson's book, *12 Rules for Life*, in his office at U. of Guelph. 6 students attended at least once and 3 attended most of the sessions.

Keith met with 5 students during drop-in hours in March, as well as several more at his monthly display tables at both campuses and Conversations That Matter at UW.
