Good But Not Religious is an expansion of Spiritual But Not Religious, Keith Martin's nonreligious chaplaincy at U. of Waterloo and U. of Guelph from 2014-20. SBNR Waterloo and SBNR Guelph were sponsored by Spectrum Artistic and Education Media Association and St. John's United Church. Spectrum A&E Media is a non-profit, registered charity promoting media arts in education and fostering values that enhance life. Keith retired from campus work in May, and in June Spectrum's board voted to bring Spectrum to a well-deserved end.

SPECTRUM CELEBRATES 40 YEARS

Started in 1980, Spectrum has gone through 3 major chapters: Exploring Values and Beliefs (1980-88), Probing Social Concerns (1989-2012), and Exploring Spirituality (2013-20). After 40 years it will be dissolved as a non-profit corporation and registered charity at its final Annual General Meeting in Wiarton, ON on July 19, 2020.
